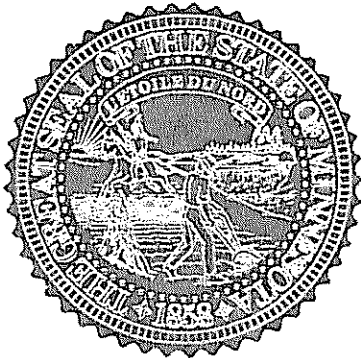
# Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Public works infrastructure, facilities, and services are of vital importance to the health, safety, and well-being of the people of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Such facilities and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, engineers, and administrators representing, state and local units of government; and
- WHEREAS: These individuals are responsible for, and must design, build, operate, and maintain, the transportation, water supply, sewage and refuse disposal systems, public building, and other structures and facilities essential to serve our citizens; and
- WHEREAS: It is in the public interest for the citizens and civic leaders of our nation to gain knowledge of, and to maintain, a progressive interest in the public works needs and programs of their respective communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM PAWLENTY, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 15 through 21, 2005, as:
