WHEREAS, Public Works services provided in our community are an integral part of our citizen's everyday lives; and

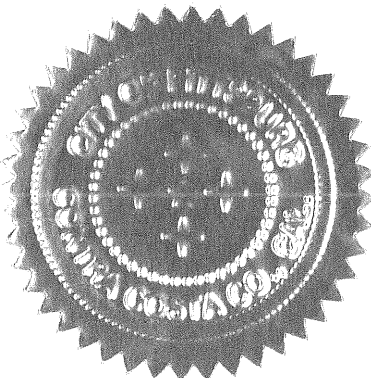


WHEREAS, the health, safety and comfort of this community greatly depends on these facilities and services; and
