1. KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP AHEAD OF YOU. NO SLOW PLAY.
2. Teams will be determined by blind draw shortly prior to shotgun start at 1pm. Some pairings will be allowed (e.g. husband and wife, etc.)
3. Each team records one score per hole.
4. From the tee each player hits his or her own golf ball. The best shot is selected. The other 3 players pick up their golf balls and move to the best-shot location. Each player then hits from the selected location. The process is followed until the ball is holed.
5. Players shall place their golf balls within one club length of the spot of the selected shot, no nearer the hole, on fairways, rough, and bunkers. The one club length may not be used to move other shots out of a hazard or onto the fairway or green (for example, if the first ball was in the bunker, the remaining shots must be from the bunker).
6. Players may place their golf balls within 1-2 inches of the selected spot on the green, no nearer the hole.
7. If the team is a threesome, at every point the team will be allowed 4 shots. The extra shot shall be rotated among the three players. ***Five-somes will not be allowed.***
8. The longest drive hole is number 3. If the prior long drive is exceeded, the player hitting the drive shall put their name next on the marker and place the marker at the location of the drive. The longest drive must be in the fairway for hole number 3.
9. The closest to the pin hole is number 6. If a player hits a tee shot closer to the pin than the prior closest shot, the player hitting the shot shall put their name next on the marker and place the marker at the location of the shot. The closest to the pin shot must be on the green for hole number 6.
10. It is hereby required that all players have fun!
