

**INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE
JENNINGS RANDOLPH APPLICANT REVIEW**

MINUTES

December 1, 2005

The special meeting to review and make final recommendations on the Jennings Randolph fellowships was called to order by Bob Kass, Chair at 4:30 p.m. Members of the committee present were Bob Kass, Chair; Marty Basta; Chris Champion; Geoff Greenough; Rachel Lazarus; and Ross Vincent. Vanessa Conrad, Dwayne Kalynchuk, Larry Lux, Zeferino Sanchez, and Diane Linderman, Board Liaison were absent. Kaye Sullivan staffed the committee.

Recommendations for Jennings Randolph Fellowships

The committee reviewed the budget proposals for each of the six candidates identified as final applicants and further discussed their proposed study projects. It was suggested that the applicants be narrowed down to one final recommendation for each country (with the exception of Mexico) in order not to reduce the Jennings Randolph Fellowship Fund to a point where it would jeopardize future fellowships.

Final recommendations to be forwarded to the Eisenhower Institute's Grants Committee are as follows:

- John Lisenko – Slovakia/Czech Republic for \$1,500
- Patricia Bugas-Schramm – New Zealand for \$1,875
- Julio Fuentes – Mexico for \$750
- Tammy Qualls – Mexico for \$750
