RECOGNIZING MAY 16 – 22, 2010 AS NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK

WHEREAS, the mission of the City of San Carlos is to provide high quality services and facilities in a fiscally sustainable, responsive and friendly manner to foster a safe and healthy community; and

WHEREAS, the San Carlos Department of Public Works provides high quality services and infrastructure in our community to fulfill this mission; and

WHEREAS, the three-year strategic planning goals of the City of San Carlos include planning for and implementing long-term financial sustainability, managing effectively the infrastructure and facilities, and enhancing community awareness, involvement and engagement; and


WHEREAS, the replacement value of the public works infrastructure owned by the City of San Carlos is estimated at over four hundred million dollars; and
